How to LOG IN

At the PD Center, the Log-In is in the upper right hand corner (small black letters); click on it.

LOG IN with your username / password provided by your administrator/coach. These are **case**

sensitive. USERNAME _____ PASSWORD _____

DO NOT SHARE your access information with anyone nor use anyone else's access information.

To do so invalidates your work. Record of your work will be kept in your membership files.

ENTER the course, *JCSpell Start-Up Training*

On the right hand side of the screen, you will see sidebar boxes.

Scroll to the one that is titled "My Courses."

Click on the course title *JCSpell Startup*.

The course will open in a listing that is much like a "Table of Contents" page.

This is how you will enter the course each time you return.

Log out is automatic after a period of disuse. Warning: Keep your account active while you complete and submit your Reflect & Write responses.

TO BEGIN

SYLLABUS. Please read carefully.

PREPARATION. Read text and watch videos about course navigation, notebook preparation, supplies, and a listing of course documents. These documents will be either be provided by your administrator/coach or they are available in the Preparations Section of the course.

SESSION 1. Begin with Session; continue sequentially through the 22 sessions of this course.

PLEASE NOTE
